We are so excited for another amazing summer at Star Center Camp! We are pleased to announce that Brionna West will be returning as the director for her fourth summer. We are excited to have her join the star staff. **Our Site Supervisor will be Scott Kassouf, Assistant Superintendent of Recreation and can be reached with any questions at 203-977-5018.** Our directors have been working hard all spring planning creative, challenging and fun activities for our campers. We would like to welcome back our veteran staff members and also the new staff members joining our team.

Together they will be working hard to give your children an exciting, safe and fun summer camp experience. **Camp will begin on Wednesday, June 24, & run until Friday, August 14, 2026.** Reminder that normal camp hours are 9:00am - 4:00pm & extended am/pm care is available for an additional charge. **Doors do not open before 9:00am each morning** unless your child in enrolled in the am program starting at 7:30AM.

### General Information

All parents/guardians must sign your child in each morning, and out each afternoon. **Camp starts at 9:00am and ends at 4:00pm.** No one is to be dropped off before **9:00am unless they are registered in AM Care.** If you are late to pickup - you will be charged \$1 per minute per child. (Ex: 15 minutes late = \$15.00) **Your child will not be allowed back at camp until the fine is paid online through your household account at [www.stamfordrecreation.com](http://www.stamfordrecreation.com) and a receipt is showed of payment.** Your child will only be dismissed to a guardian unless otherwise documented. Identification must be shown for All pickups. No exceptions! Please be mindful of applying sunscreen for your child prior to camp each morning. Once again this summer camp sign in and sign out will be done outside the main entrance to the Star Center each day. After campers are signed in they will be walked into the Star Center and the doors will be locked. **No outside visitors will be permitted in the building during the day except recreation staff and contracted entertainers.** Any parents or guardian that comes early to pick up a child will need to be buzzed in at the front door of the Star Center.



**\*Field Trip Updated!**

Star Center Day Camp will have 3 field trips this summer. Please note that if your child attends summer school on a field trip day you will need to pick up your child on that day and drive them from summer school to camp so they make the field trip that day! If you decide not to have them attend the trip they will be unable to attend camp that day. **No staff will be left behind on trip days for campers that arrive from summer school.**

**Attention Parents**

If you need to pick up your children early from camp, please supply a note that day to the campers counselor. When you arrive please call **203-977-5723** and the director will bring you children to the door.

**Any child that is having behavior problems in camp or fails to follow the above rules will receive a verbal warning first, a written warning second and the third strike will be a suspension or dismissal from camp. Any camper dismissed from camp will not be permitted to register the following year.**

**The Lunch Program will Run This Summer!**

Once again this summer we are scheduled to have the food program for lunch at the Star Center Camp. The lunch program will run from June 24th through August 14th. The lunch program will cover the entire duration of camp. A menu for each upcoming week will be sent home in the Star Center Newsletter every Friday. If you do not want your child to participate in the food program, please pack a lunch each day in a cooler bag with an ice pack. **If you have any further questions about the lunch program, please see the camp director on the first day of camp.**

**Splash Pad and Water Days**

**We will have scheduled trips to the Scalzi Park Splash pad throughout the summer that will be announced ahead of time. Please make sure you pack a swim suit every day with towel for outside water games.** If you have any questions please speak with your child's

**Star Center Camp Rules 2026**

1. Treat fellow campers and counselors with respect.
2. Listen to your counselor at all times.
3. Keep your hands to yourself. No kicking, biting, hitting, throwing objects....If you have a problem tell your counselor.
4. Stay with your group at all times. Tell your counselors if you need to leave the group for any reason.
5. Swearing and other inappropriate language (in any language) is not allowed.
6. Smoking or vaping is not allowed by anyone at camp.
7. Clean up all supplies and equipment used in camp at the end of an activity. Pick up any trash and make sure you clean up your area after lunch.
8. Respect other people's property. No taking or breaking items that belong to others.
9. Fighting is not allowed in camp. Anyone who does not follow this rule will be immediately taken to the Camp Director.
10. Shoes or sneakers must be worn at camp.
11. No going to the bathroom on your own without a staff member.
12. No cell phones or portable video game devices are permitted at camp. (If you choose to send a cell phone it can be brought to camp but must remain off and left in a child's backpack, the camp is not responsible if anything happens).
13. Campers can only call home if there is an emergency. (There is a camp phone in the office and the Directors will reach out to parents if needed.)
14. Campers must wear the camp t-shirt on all field trips.
15. Campers must wear bathing suits in the water.
16. Campers must sit in their seats on all bus trips and any child that cannot listen will sit in front of the bus with a staff member.
17. Toys from home are not permitted at camp. (If you bring them, the camp is not responsible if anything happens to them, best to leave them at home.)

**Disciplinary Action Procedure for ALL Campers**

**First Offense:** Verbal Warning on paper

**Second Offense:** Written Warning in file

**Third Offense:** Meeting / Dismissal from Camp ( Any camper dismissed from camp will not be eligible to register the following year.)

### Summer School Parents:

If your child will be attending summer school during the month of July, please notify the camp director in writing the first day of camp. Also, parents must arrange with the Board of Education to have their child/children bussed from summer school to the Star Day Camp program each day. The Stamford Recreation Department does not supply transportation to camp! Also, on field trip days any child that goes to summer school will need to be picked up by their parents from school early to make the trip. Camp trips depart from 10:30AM to 11:30am and if you cannot get them there for the trip, they will need to go home from summer school on that day. We will not have staff left behind to accept them from summer at the normal school drop off time. Please see our director if you have any questions.



### Ice Cream Truck

Once again this summer the ice cream truck will stop at the Camp after lunch on select days. Once we have set up the schedule it will be announced in the weekly news letter and it is up to each family if they would like their campers to purchase ice cream on those days. When entering the Star Center parking lot please drive slowly as you make your way down the hill to the parking area.
