Will the Lunch Program Run This Summer!

Once again this summer we are scheduled to have the food program for lunch at Davenport Camp. The lunch program will be not available the first day of camp so all campers should bring a bagged lunch and beverage June 21, 2021. The lunch program will start Tuesday, June 22 and run until August 6, 2021. A menu for each upcoming week will be sent home in the Davenport Newsletter every Friday. If you do not want your child to participate in the food program, please pack a lunch each day in a cooler bag with an ice pack. If you have any further questions about the lunch program, please see the camp director on the first day of camp.

Aquatics /Swimming

Davenport Day Camp will be swimming at Westhill Pool this summer and a weekly schedule will be posted the first day of camp. Please have your child bring his or her bathing suit, towel and other supplies they may need on days that they're assigned to go swimming. **Camper must wear a bathing to be allowed into the water. Your child may also bring a life jacket if necessary. If your child does not know how to swim please tell the camp director on the first day of camp in writing with a note. For more information on swimming, please see your child's counselors.**

Field Trips: With the busing restrictions put in place by the State of CT we have not scheduled any field trips. This may change during the course of the summer!

Davenport Camp Rules

- 1. Treat fellow campers and counselors with respect.**
2. Counselors must be treated as teachers are during the school year.
3. Keep your hands to yourself; no kicking, hitting, biting or throwing objects.
4. Stay with your group at all times, you must ask to use the bathroom.
5. Swearing and other inappropriate language will not be tolerated at camp.
6. Smoking is prohibited on or near camp grounds.
7. Clean up your lunch table and group room.
8. Respect others belongings and backpacks.
9. Fighting is not allowed at camp and is grounds for suspension and/or dismissal.
10. **Sneakers must be worn at all times. NO SANDALS!**
11. **Leave all personal items at home. Toys, cell-phones, Apple watches, etc. should not be brought to camp.**
12. Do not bring any sharp objects or weapons to camp.
14. Safety first; rules are made for the safety of the group.
15. Raise your hand to get your counselors attention.
16. NO child is allowed in the woods or outside without a staff member.
17. Wear sunscreen at all times, and bring a reusable water bottle to camp.
18. **No bullying, including racial intolerance.**
19. **Camper are not permitted to go home with anyone except their parent/guardian without written permission in advance. Please see a staff member for a permission slip form.**



State Informed Consent Form Required

Parents will be required to sign a State Informed Consent Form prior to the start of camp to attend. The Form will be posted on the Recreation Website under camp forms and must be handed in on the first day of camp to the director.

Attention Parents

If you need to pick up your children early from camp, please supply a note that day to the campers counselor. When you arrive please call (Davenport #) 203-977-4132 and the director will bring you children to the door.

Any child that is having behavior problems in camp or fails to follow the above rules will receive a verbal warning first, a written warning second and the third strike will be a suspension or dismissal from camp. Any camper dismissed from camp will not be permitted to register the following year.

STAMFORD RECREATION CAMP PROCEDURES

Parents/Guardians should not send children to camp with any illness, fever or cough.

All staff and children will be checked each morning for any observable illness, including cough by the director before entering the camp. Although it is not required by the OEC we will once again be taking temperatures to confirm all children are below 100 degrees Fahrenheit. Any staff or campers that have a temperature 100 degrees or greater are not permitted at camp that day.

Staff members will be required to wash hands with soap several times per day and if no sink is available they will apply hand sanitizer.

Any child that becomes sick during the day will be immediately removed from the group and the parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up the child.

All staff will be required to wear a mask at all times in the building during camp.

All campers are required to wear a face mask at all times while attending camp indoors and **will be allowed to remove them for outdoor activities.**

Appropriate social distancing protocols will be put in place during camp group activities following OEC guidelines when camp starts.

Children will be required to wash their hands with soap and water and if a sink is not available with hand sanitizer:

***Before and after eating**

***After using the rest room**

*** After sneezing, coughing or blowing their nose**

***After using shared equipment**

* We will continue to clean all sports and art equipment after each group usage.

* Once groups are set and requests before camp are in place we will not make changes.

Once campers have been screened in the morning at outside the facility, they will then report to a sign in table with their parent/guardian.

Parents/Guardians dropping off and picking up campers will not be permitted in the building past the sign In/out table each day. We understand that some parents/guardians will not be happy with this procedure, but it is for safety.

While our goal is to provide the best summer camp we can for campers, the health and safety of the campers and staff is our top priority. **Thank you for your understanding.**

Parents and campers should be 3 feet apart while waiting to sign in or out according to OEC and CDC guidelines.

Groups will not participate with other groups during activities until further notice.

Only one group at a time will be permitted to use the rest rooms and a max of 8 children at once in the rest room.

Groups will be a max of 20 children per group even though the OEC says the groups can be Larger as of May 31.

Groups will not overlap in the hallways while switching activities.

At this time the pools will be open for summer camp unless the state changes the regulations. Only 40 children (two groups) will be allowed in the pool at one time.

Field trips have not been decided upon this summer and will be determined by the bus use restrictions. We will update you once camp begins on the status.

Art Instructors will clean and sanitize supplies after each group usage.

Lunch will be provided at all sites again this year except Heroy Camp by Chartwells. Bagged lunches will be supplied unless this changes. **Lunch will not be served on June 21st and all campers must bring a lunch!**

In the event that a camper or staff member is diagnosed with Covid-19. All individuals assigned to that group will be required to self-quarantine for 10 days. If all protocols stated herein are followed, confirmed by the camp director/ health department, the remaining groups will be permitted to continue normal camp activities. **The Stamford Health Department will be notified ASAP and guide us through the situation. This is subject to change!**

No outside visitors accept approved by the Recreation staff and camp shows.

No camp picnic or family day

No camp to camp visits this summer.

Signs will be posted throughout the camp on washing hands and keeping masks on.

Note: Some procedure and policies are subject to change depending on the State of CT requirements before June 21st or during camp.
